PRESENTER GUIDELINES

Your program can consist of as many presenters as you would like. If you are presenting with a group, please list all group members, but designate one person as the contact for the entire group. Use this person's email address and phone number for the contact info.

CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS

Panels are presented from the stage in the Community Room to a large audience (potentially 30+ people). This type of program is typically a more lecture-based, Q&A style that tends to appeal to larger audiences. It may include one presenter or a panel of presenters. While an introduction may be made, panels are expected to be hosted by their leaders.

Fan Meetups are presented to a smaller audience (generally 10-20 people). This type of program is typically a more discussion-based, informal style that tends to appeal to smaller groups. It generally includes one or two presenters. Fan Meetups will not receive introductions and are expected to be hosted by their leaders.

Activity Zones may be presented in a wide variety of formats, including (but not limited to) an arcade-like gaming lounge or a crafting or DIY course related to a certain fandom. These are highly interactive areas, where con participants are encouraged to be part of the action. Activity Zone leaders are responsible for providing the equipment and supplies necessary for the activity and will not hold the library accountable for any potential damage.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION
